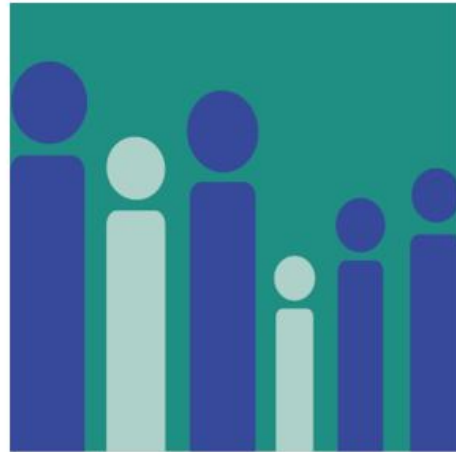

Highlights...

Mental Health Counseling



- ✦ Provided Individual and family counseling to more than 660 adult and child consumers.
- ✦ Hosted four-part educational series for Mental Health Awareness month.
- ✦ Provided 115 individuals with a variety of mental health educational presentations throughout the year.

Child Abuse Prevention Education



- ✦ Educated 25,131 individuals about child abuse prevention.
- ✦ Provided 174 Play it Safe Presentations.
- ✦ Provided 140 Bully Prevention Presentations.
- ✦ Provided Darkness to Light Training to 124 adults.
- ✦ Provided 2,319 parents/caregivers with the Period of Purple Crying Bedside education at CRH and Major Health hospitals.
- ✦ Provided 48 infant and toddler Safety presentations.
- ✦ Distributed more than 2,500 pinwheels throughout the community.

Year-at-a-Glance...

2019 Accomplishments

- We provided services to 25,797 individuals in and around Bartholomew County. This is a 5.9% increase from last year.
- Board Members started the year off with the development of a 3-year strategic plan.
- Attended 16 community agency fairs and events where we shared knowledge and various community resources with over 1,000 attendees.
- Successfully launched the Darkness to Light Pilot Program.
- Increased our Fundraising events.

"A student at the beginning of the school year refused to come into the school in the mornings due to feeling anxious around her peers. She and her parents engaged in school-based therapy twice a week and within 2 weeks of learning to identify triggers and learning some new coping skills, she began coming to school daily without any issues. 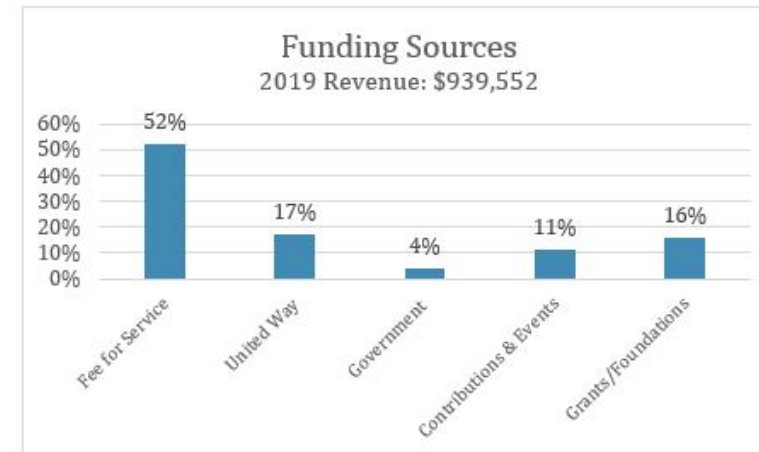
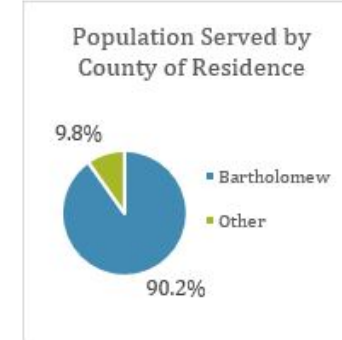
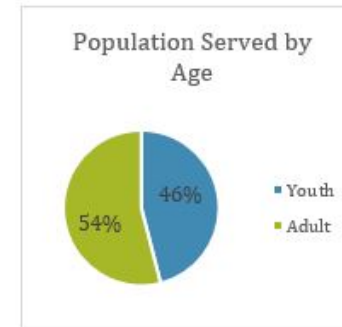
